The committee responded to the request saying that not just one event should be taped, the cost given to them was high for one event only and the possible liability issues the town may run into with people being taped with out consent was a large concern. The board agreed that the town should not be using the celebration account money for video tapping any of the events. A general disclosure will be put up at each event warning participants that pictures and video may happen by other event participants and that they can not hold the town liable for any reasoning due to being informed.
