OLD BUSINESS:

1. Salt & Sand Shed Repair-Al Hodsdon 873-5164

Rick Moore spoke with Al Hodsdon several weeks ago and ask for him to contact the office with the information needed but the office has not heard from Al Hodsdon.

2. Review FD Office Duties Service Agreement

When a newly elected Clerk is in place after town meeting, that person will automatically be the deputy Register of Voters per law and may be appointed by the board as the regular Register of Voters.

5. Pine Tree Rd

The board asked David Kincaid to look at the Pine Tree Rd and see how bad the current cracks are and if they will need to be addressed before this summer.
