OLD BUSINESS:

1. 2017 & 2018 Foreclosures

a. Bid Notices to Mail signing for March 2, 2021 (Knowles, Carbone)

The AA informed the board that at the March 2nd, 2021 board meeting, the paperwork will be ready to sign to send to the two above property owners notifying them the foreclosure bid process has started.

b. Payment Arrangements with Belomizi & Harville Updates

Thomas Harville has been paying his monthly payments and the Belomizi's have until March 31st to pay their taxes in full.

1. Public Hearing for FY 2021-22 Proposed Budget

6. Somerset County Budget Committee Info

The board received information on the Somerset County Budget Committee looking for nominations for budget committee members.

7. North Shore Drive Turn Around
