The summary of the May 18th, 2021, meeting minutes was approved as typed.

Justin Furbush motioned to accept the meeting minutes from May 18th as typed. Molly Chapman seconded the motion. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Municipal Parking Lot Paving Bid Specs

The Warren Brothers are working on a proposal for the board.

2. Town Roads

a. Price for 6" Gravel & Winter Sand

The board discussed the local options for 6" gravel & winter sand for town uses. The AA sent messages to Len Poulin, Labbe Construction, Warren Brothers, and had not gotten to Churchill Sand & Gravel as of the meeting.

Rick Moore will contact Dale Churchill owner of Churchill Sand & Gravel and ask that he attend the next meeting for discussion of his prices.

3. Fire Dept

Fire Chief, Jack Easler talked to the board about the department discussing tower options with US Cellular. Jack will keep the board updated.

Judy Easler, Independent Secretary for the fire department informed the board that she will be resigning. The board discussed how to advertise for the position. The AA will work on gathering information and a job description to discuss at the next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Bickford Rd Residents Petition June 15th

A formal petition was submitted to the Town Registrar and will be submitted to the board at their June 15th meeting.

2. Audit Representation Letter

Molly Chapman motioned to have Rick Moore sign the Audit Representation Letter for final approval of the 2020-21 FY Audit. Justin Furbush seconded the motion. Motion passed.

3. Cemetery Conveyance Gould Cemetery Lot F16 John & Fawn Paradis

Justin Furbush motioned to sign the Gould Cemetery Conveyance for Lot F16 to John & Fawn Paradis. Molly Chapman seconded the motion. Motion passed.

4. Request for Amish sign North Shore Drive

Residents have called the office requesting that the town put up signs indicating Amish horse and buggy usage of Lake View Drive and North Shore Drive. Lake View Drive is a state-maintained road, and a request will need to be put in to the MDOT. The board agreed to wait and see what the state allows before deciding on a sign for North Shore Drive.
