

# **NO PARKING ORDINANCE FOR NORTH POND BOAT LANDING**

**Adopted: June 6, 2006**

## **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENTS**

No person shall park any motor vehicle at any time within the "Tie Down Area" and the "Ready Area", at the North Pond Boat Landing located on North Shore Drive. The fact that any vehicle is illegally parked is prima facie evidence that the person to whom it is registered has parked it.

## **SECTION 2. NOTICE**

An appropriate sign shall be erected in the vicinity of the no parking area, notifying the public of the prohibition.

## **SECTION 3. AUTHORITY**

This ordinance shall become effective when enacted by a majority of the Municipal Officers pursuant to 30-A M.R.S.A. S3009.

## **SECTION 4. PENALTY**

The penalty for violation of this ordinance will be: Persons violating this ordinance are subject of District Court Proceedings and shall be subject to a fine of up to \$100.00, payable to the Town of Smithfield. Persons charged with the violations may waive the court action by paying the Tax Collector a fee of \$10.00 within 7 days after receiving notice of the violation.

## **SECTION 5. ENFORCEMENT**

The Municipal Officers, or their duly appointed designee, shall enforce this ordinance.

## **SECTION 6. EXCEPTIONS:**

This ordinance does not apply to motor vehicles parked in the prohibited area for up to 12 hours for the following reasons: Mechanical problems or breakdown, Emergency situations, Maintenance, construction, repair or installation of utilities or the public way by any State or Municipal agency or utility Co.

## **SECTION 7. APPEALS**

Any person who shall deem himself/herself aggrieved by failure or refusal of the person authorized to enforce the ordinance, may appeal the decision to the Board of Selectpersons at any time within thirty (30) days of notification of the violation, by informing the Board of Selectmen, in writing, of the appeal.
